



# Carberry Collegiate Carberry, Manitoba 2022-2023 Report to the Community



## About Carberry Collegiate

Carberry Collegiate is a place where each individual's rights are respected. In an environment of safety, trust and fairness, each student can set personal and educational goals, can get involved in and become a productive member of our school and community.

## School Profile

We are a 5—12 school with a total population of 293 students (June 2023). Of the total school population, 57% are male and 42% are female. Enrollment in grade 5 –8 is 155, and 138 students are enrolled in 9-12.

Instructional staff consists of 23 teachers, along with 9 support staff. Delivery of remote learning and the use of google classroom was accomplished by staff and students during the school year. We are able to deliver programs in Music, Phys. Ed., Home Ec, Industrial Arts, Robotics, Advanced Math and French, plus offer Resource and Counselling Support. Speech Pathologist services are also available to our students. We also had many students complete credits through the High School Apprenticeship Program

Space is made available to outside agencies to meet with clients as needed. (AFM, Mental Health, Family Services, CFS) Carberry Collegiate staff remain committed to the infusion of technology across all curricula. Chromebooks continue to be available for students and are used on a regular basis. Use of personal devices also continues.

CC hosts a web page (<http://carberrycollegiate.weebly.com>) for student, parent and community access. An initiative between the school and local councils has resulted in youth councilor position on the town and RM council and the library board.

## 2022-2023

The following are some highlights and pieces of data from the 2022/2023 school year.

### Student Records

The use of a new students records system, Powerschools came into effect at the start of the school year. The system now has a parent portal available which allows parents access to marks.

### Fountas & Pinnell results

In 2022-2023 86% of Carberry Collegiate students in grades 5-8 showed growth in their reading, while 77% of students are reading at or above grade level.

### Math/mRLC results

Math results indicated that 70% of students have reached their grade baseline (60% or better)

### Credit Achievement

Manitoba Education reported that in 2021-2022 Carberry Collegiate had pass rates of:  
95% in Grade 9 Math  
83% in Grade 9 ELA

Grade 10 Assessments and Grade 12 Provincial exams in Math and ELA will be implemented beginning the fall of 2023. This will provide information on student knowledge and skills going forward that teachers can use to design instruction.
